We are excited to announce the return of Squamish Days Loggers Sports Show on September 18, 2021!

Traditionally we host a 5-day festival with over 10 community events including separate Open and Novice/Intermediate Logging Shows. As our local health restrictions have just softened, we are jumping at the opportunity to bring our community together, and to host a condensed version of our festival.

We will be combining our Open & Novice/Intermediate shows into a **1 day show on September 18, 2021 @ 1:30pm.**

With condensed show time and limited time to prepare we have also made the difficult decision to remove the following events from our 2021 show:

- Open & Intermediate Springboard Chop
- Tree Topping (80ft. Climb)
- Power Saw Tree Falling

New This Year Our 140cc Hot Saw Event has been changed to an open hot saw event. Our committee has been working hard to arrange the 2021 festival but with limited time, and a softened local economy, we do not have the budget to award prize money at this time. There are no event entry fees but you are still required to check in at the office, sign our waiver and pay the \$1.00 Squamish Days membership fee in order to compete. We will supply competitors with our show shirt and trophies will continue to be awarded.

We understand the cost, time and commitment competitors make to attend shows and apologize for any disappointment this announcement creates. This is a topic that has been discussed in great depth and this decision was not made lightly.

Our 2021 objectives are to dust off the competition cobwebs, bring our Loggers Sports family together and celebrate community! **Changes made to the 2021 show are not permanent and we hope to return to our regular scheduled festival August 4-8, 2022 for our 65th Anniversary.**

Just a reminder, ladies competing in the Ladies exclusive events can only enter one class/event. For example, you can enter the Ladies axe throw event *or* the Novice *or* Open Axe Throw event, but you cannot enter more than one.

Junior Birling eliminations will be held at the Al McIntosh Loggers Sports Grounds on Friday, September 17 @ 7:00pm. Top 2 competitors will compete in the show.

As in the past, we have complementary camping spaces available on the show grounds on a first come, first serve basis - including un-serviced space for RV's. Portable toilets are supplied throughout the show grounds and access to potable water is provided.

Once again, we will be enforcing the rule that only competitors be allowed on the infield for the morning preliminaries and during the show. Anyone entering the infield must either be a member of Squamish Days or have signed a waiver. All family members and non-competitors must be seated in the designated areas. Also, at registration you will be given passes for each of your immediate family members and a parking pass for your vehicle. This pass must be carried and shown to our security whenever re-entering the grounds (there will be no access to the grounds without this pass).
